Preparation

Position the motorcycle securely on its stand or a work stand. Cover the front fender and fuel tank with a suitable cloth to avoid scratches from dropped tools.



Left and right side of motorcycle and product are determined while sitting on the bike.

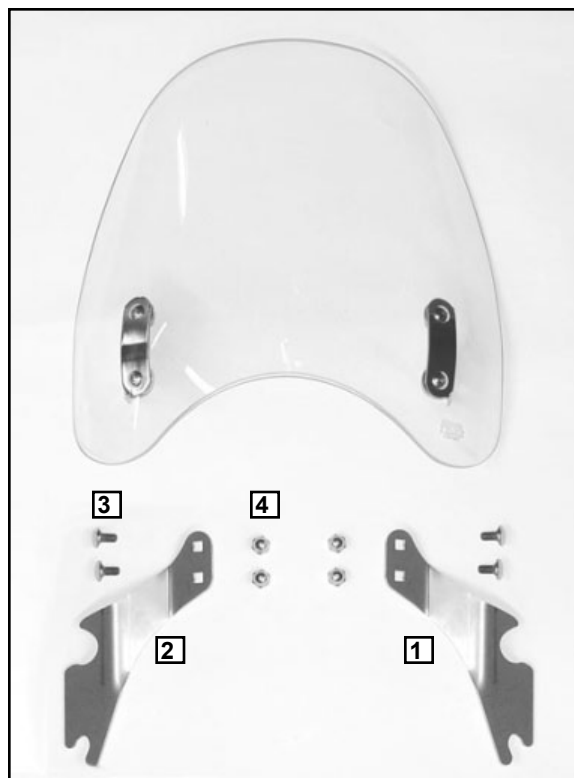

INSTALLATION ATTACH THE BRACKETS TO THE WINDSHIELD



When properly identified and installed, Bracket bends outboard. Bracket mounts outboard to the pre-assembled windshield mount as well.

1. Identify right side Bracket (2).

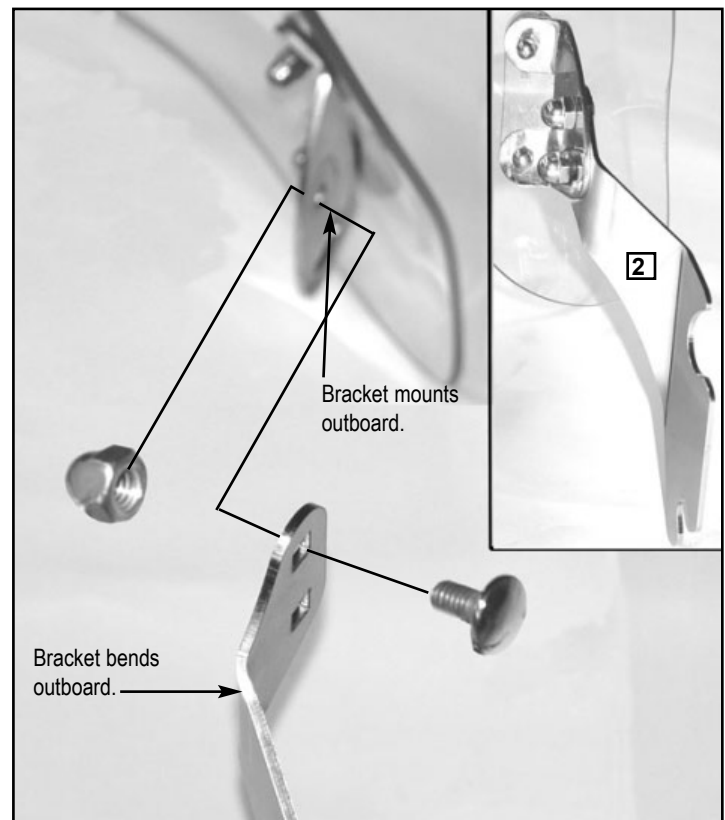


Figure 2. Right Side Bracket Assembly

2. Assemble right Bracket to right side of windshield with Carriage Bolts (3) and Nuts (4). Be certain Bolt neck seats correctly in Bracket. **(9/16 Socket and Wrench) Figure 2.**

ADJUST BRACKETS, TIGHTEN TO "HOLD"

3. Repeat on left side. For now, adjust Brackets so notched edge is perpendicular to the ground and screen has a slight rake. Tighten to hold. **Figure 3.**

INSTALL WINDSHIELD TO MOTORCYCLE, ADJUST AND TIGHTEN SECURLY

4. Refer to the SwitchBlade Owner's Manual attached to the windshield and install shield to motorcycle. Make final adjustments to rake and tighten Nuts (4) firmly (15 ft/lbs.) **(9/16 Socket and Wrench)**

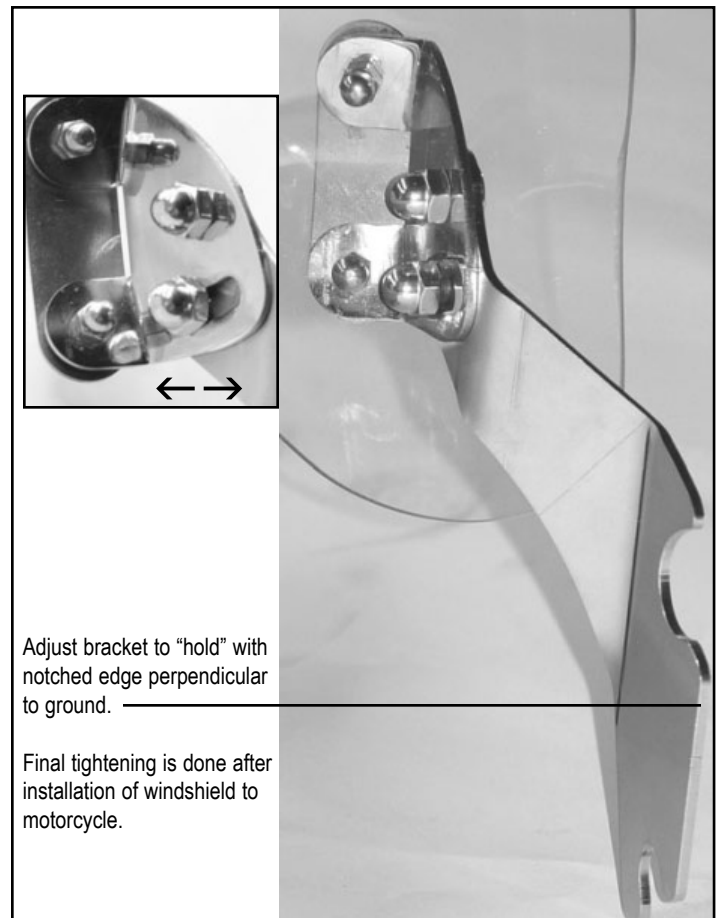

Preparation



Proper tightening of this assembly is critical. Use a Torque Wrench!

Follow this procedure! Correct assembly of this kit will provide years of reliable service.

Position the motorcycle securely on its stand or a work stand. Cover the front fender and fuel tank with a suitable cloth to avoid scratches from dropped tools.

INSTALLATION to MOTORCYCLES WITH COVERED FORKS



This instruction covers many motorcycles with covered forks. Check the parts list of your particular kit for these items:

The Clamp Straps (7 and 8) are numbered on the inside. Verify you have the correct top and bottom straps using the parts list provided.

Some Spiders (9) have different length studs, if this is the case in your kit, **The longer stud goes on the top.**

INSTALLATION

1. On all model motorcycles with covered forks, adhere the Burr Barrier (10) to the upper triple clamp. **Figure 1.**

2. Place the Clamp Straps (7 and 8) onto the fork tube or fork cover. **The larger Clamp Strap goes below the smaller one.**

3. If your Spider Bracket (9) has different length studs, **the longer one goes on the top.**



- 1, Hex Key Wrench, 4mm
- 1, Torque Wrench that accurately measures 75 inch pounds. (8.6 Nm)

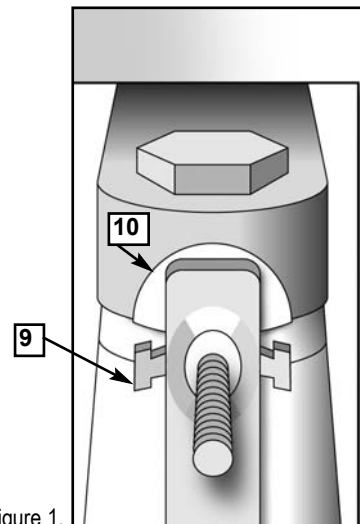
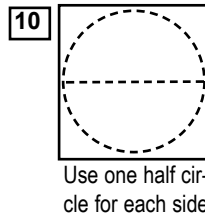

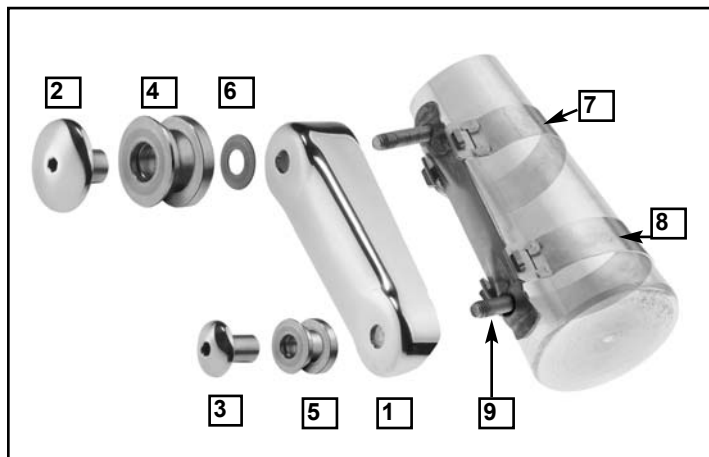

4. Hook a Spider Bracket onto the Clamp Straps, hook the lower Clamp Strap first. **Figure 3.**

5. Position the Mounting Cup (1) on to the Spider Bracket so the studs protrude from the holes. **Figure 2.**



The longer side of the Mounting Cup always goes on the top. Figure 4.

6. Place a Brass Washer (6) onto the top stud. **Figure 2.**

7. Push the large Upper Nut (2) into the large Upper Spool (4) so the thin side of the spool is near the head of the Upper Nut. **Figure 2.**

8. Start the Upper Spool, onto the upper stud, **(4mm Hex Key)**

9. Assemble the Lower Spool (5) and Lower Nut (3) so the thin side of the Spool is near the head of the Lower Nut.

10. Start the Lower Nut/Spool onto the lower stud. **(4mm Hex Key)**

11. Repeat steps 1 through 10 on the other fork.

12. Verify that the Burr Barriers (10) are located between the Mounting Cup end and any aluminum part, fork or triple clamp. **Figure 4.**

13. Adjust both Mounting Cups front to rear so they are in line across the forks.

 **Misalignment can cause damage to fuel tank and will cause the system to not work properly. Check alignment carefully. Turn the fork carefully to the stops. Make sure the gap between the Spools and the fuel tank are the same on both sides.**

14. Tighten the Nuts to 75 INCH POUNDS (8.6 Nm) **Figure 5.**
(Torque Wrench, 4mm Hex Wrench.)



This assembly will not “feel” like tightening a normal nut and bolt. Tightening from 25in/lbs to 50in/lbs will take at least one full turn.

15. Refer to the instructions packaged with the SwitchBlade wind-shield. Install the shield. Make sure all components line up.



16. Cycle the shield through the mount and dismount 5 times.



17. Retighten the Nuts to 75 INCH POUNDS. (8.6 Nm).
Enjoy your SwitchBlade Windshield.

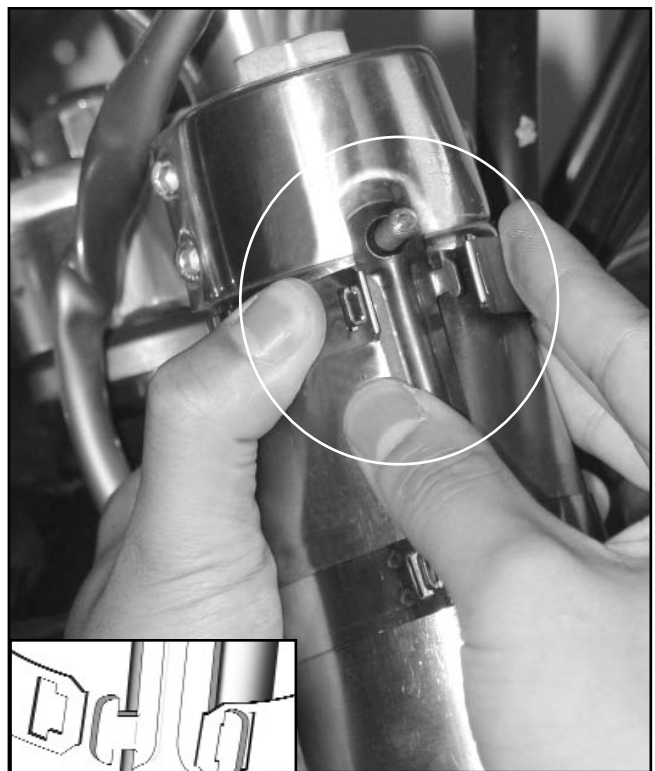
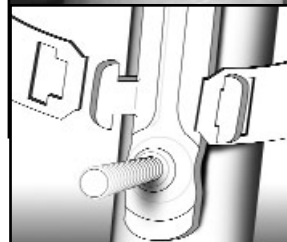
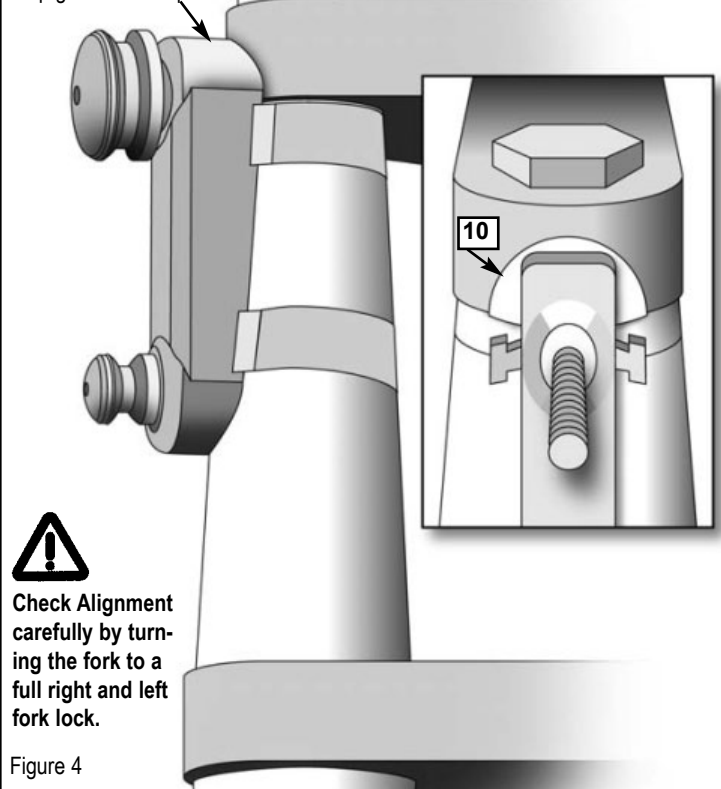

Engage the bottom clamp strap to the spider first. Be sure spider hook is fully and correctly seated into the slot.

The longer side of the Mount Cup goes to the top.



 **Check Alignment carefully by turning the fork to a full right and left fork lock.**
